



DRYING INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPEL PRODUCTS

- On newer dryers it is recommended that the inlet and outlet temperatures need to be specified
- For the inlet temperature – 130 °C
- For the outlet temperature – 70 °C
- Caution should be taken that the product will melt at 184 For the inlet temperature – 130 °C and hot spots can develop where the inlet air reaches the dryer
- It is recommended to run a trial load through the process to ensure that melting does not occur
- The longest item to dry in the Compel range is the cuffs on gowns
- The normal load in a dryer at 70 °C should take about 5 minutes
- It is advisable to have a cool down cycle
- To avoid excessive creasing it is suggested that once the product has been dried, it is laid out flat upon being taken out of the dryer
