



## LAUNDRING INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPEL PRODUCTS

- Compel products must always be laundered prior to use (*This is because the products will contain some dirt and dust that has been picked up during the manufacturing process*)
- Compel products are to be washed on their own – if washed with other products it will attract lint which can cause infections
- Compel products must be washed according to the set process – failure to follow this will cause damage to the products
- Compel products must be washed using 5 rinse cycles to ensure the removal of any residual detergent
- Rinsing cycles are never to be reduced
- The final rinse cycle must be below 30 ppm total alkalinity
