



The Home Based/Community Support Worker provides assistance and support to consumers with psychiatric, drugs & alcohol related needs to manage their recovery plan. This support and assistance is directly supervised by a Registered Nurse, who is responsible for the assessment planning & evaluation of care.

The Home based/Community Support Worker is directly supervised in the provision of care that focuses on successful recovery based outcomes for consumers and their family whanau.

Core Responsibilities of the Home Based /Community Support Worker

- Supports clinical processes which aim to improve the care & outcomes of the consumer, & reports back regularly to the RN - clinical changes in the presentation of the consumer, - community functioning and the care provided to each person.
- Assists, as directed, in the care & functioning of the consumer, including support in the home, transport & community activities, in a culturally aware manner.
- Has input into the three monthly review with the consumer, to ensure that their recovery treatment plan includes support and activities consistent with the consumers current needs.
- Assists consumers, (their family whanau) to be involved with the care planning process, and that all involved have a signed copy of the agreed plan.
- Works with the MDT in establishing clear and open channels of communication in respect of recovery care planning.
