



Flow Chart for District Nurses Receiving Calls from Stomal Patients

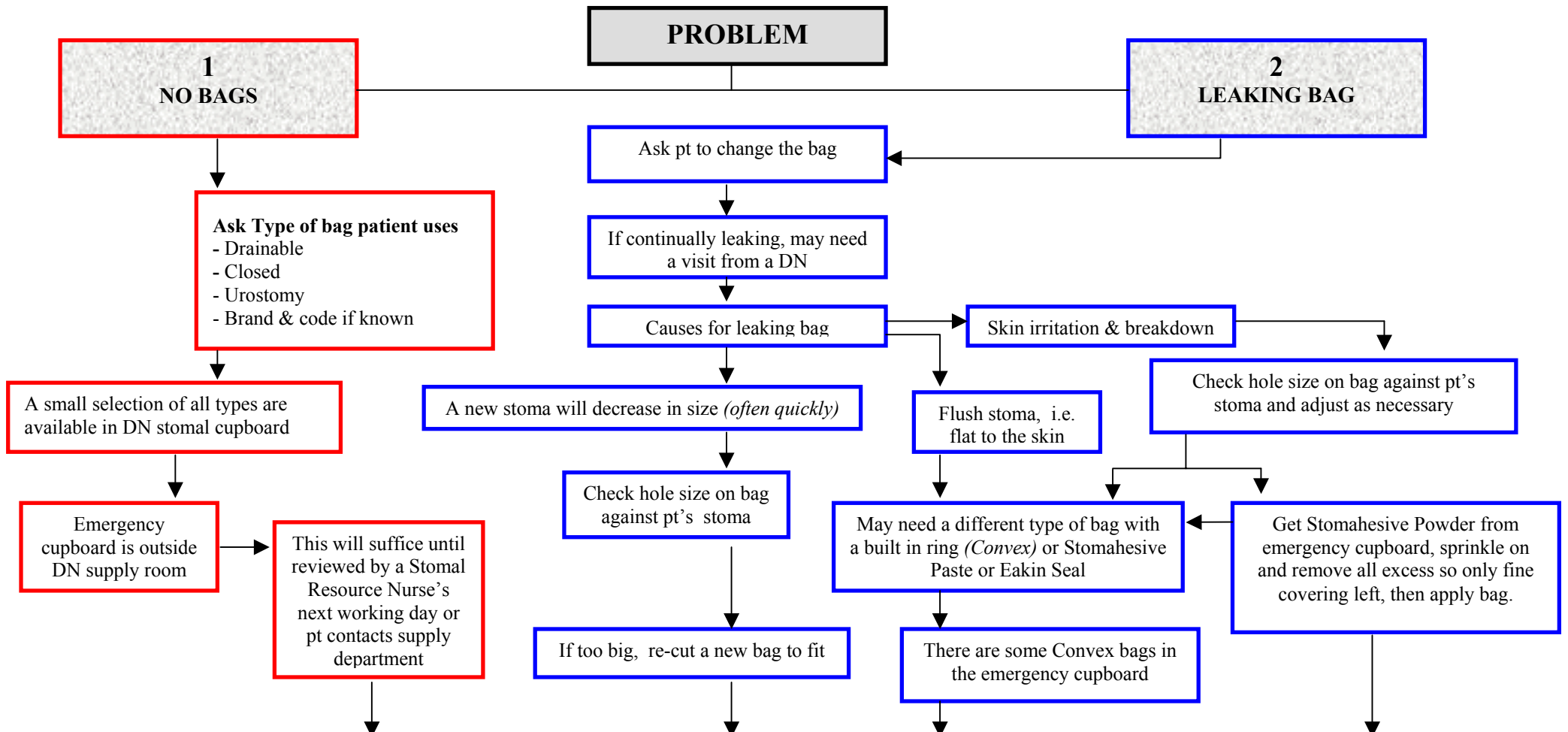
Speak with the caller to outline problems.

Establish stoma type. i.e. – Colostomy - Ileostomy - Urostomy - And if surgery was recent

All stomal patients recently discharged from hospital should have a kit bag containing their current products plus outlining their operation and cares

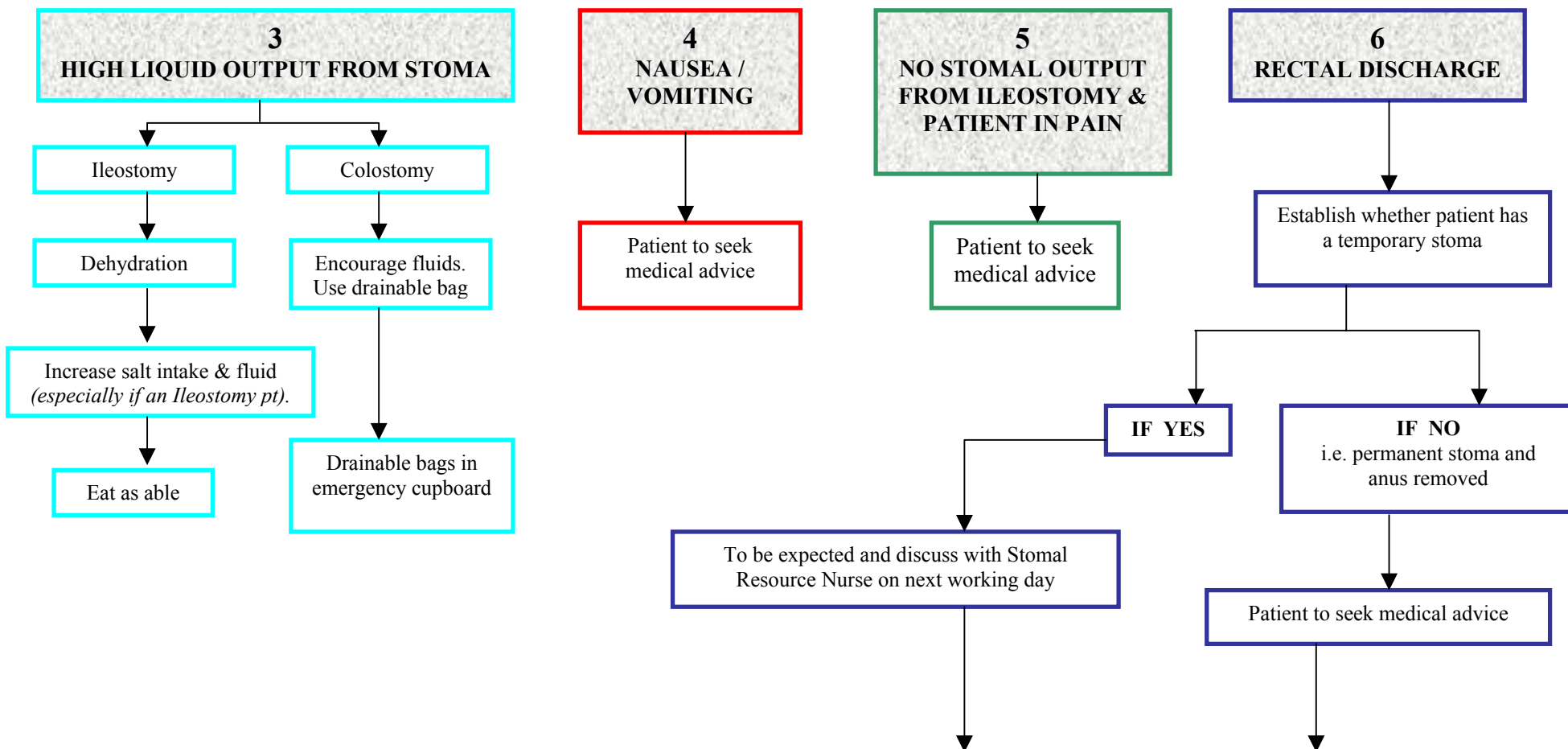
